

Freedom Rides Museum Seasonal Staff

The Alabama Historical Commission seeks a part-time staff person at the Freedom Rides Museum.

This Civil Rights museum is located in the historic Greyhound Bus Station in downtown Montgomery where in May 1961, an integrated group of 22 college students known as the Freedom Riders met mob violence with non-violence and courage. Their actions helped end racial segregation in all interstate transportation.

This position will work on site to support museum operations during hours museum open to the public.

Schedule workdays: Thursday - Saturdays at the museum, 210 South Court Street

Time: 11 am - 4 pm (up to 20 hours per week)

Duties: Museum operations with an emphasis on retail including:

- Operating a Point of Sale (POS) system with cash and credit card transactions.
- Assisting with basic reports on daily transactions and retail sales.
- Reconciling cash register record with receipts.
- Assisting with stocking retail.

Minimum age required: 18 years or older

Training will be provided.

Basic retail knowledge and experience with a POS system, printer/scanner preferred.

Salary and Benefits

The starting hourly rate is \$7.85. There are no additional benefits with this position.
