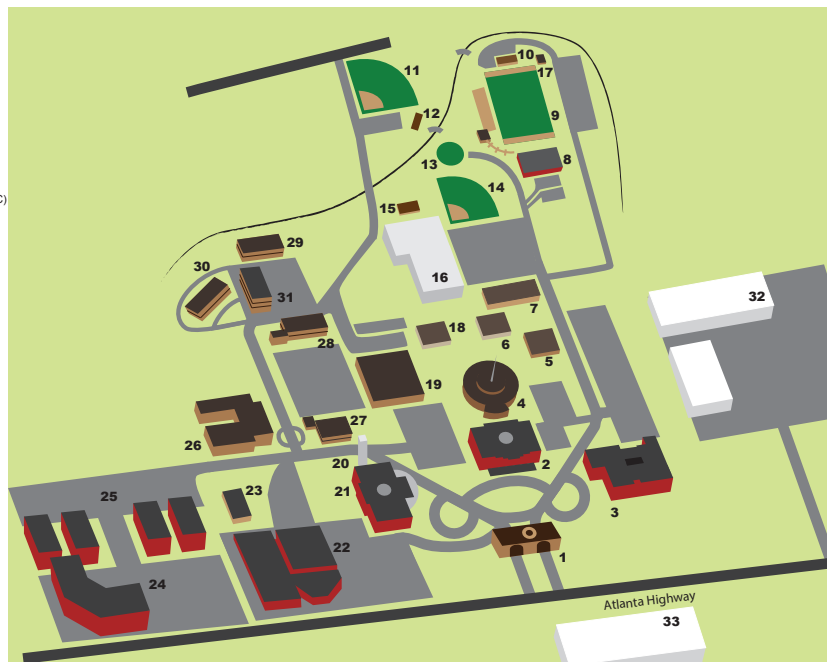

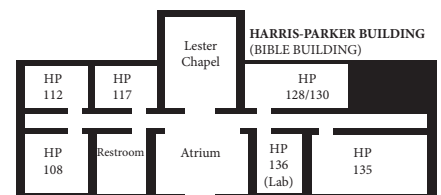
Campus Map

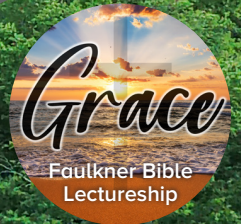

David W. Hester is Professor of New Testament for the V. P. Black College of Biblical Studies and the Kearley Graduate School of Theology at Faulkner University. He serves as Director of the Faulkner Bible Lectureship. Hester has been preaching since 1978, and is a third-generation Gospel preacher; he also is Associate Minister at Elmore church of Christ. He received the B. A. cum laude in Bible from Freed-Hardeman in 1987, the M. A. summa cum laude in Bible from Amridge University in 1990, and the Ph.D. in New Testament summa cum laude from the Turner School of Theology at Amridge in June 2013. Hester is the author of four books: *Among the Scholars* (1994), *Tampering With Truth* (2007), *Does Mark 16:9—20 Belong In The New Testament?* (2015), and *Jesus Christ: A Thematic Study* (2023). He has had three public debates: one with Roman Catholic theologian Robert Sungenis on Authority (2011), and two with Don K. Preston on Realized Eschatology (2016, 2017).

Bill J. Pascrell, III is a lobbyist with Princeton Public Affairs Group. Pascrell led the successful 10-year campaign to legalize sports betting in the United States culminating with the repeal of PASPA by the United States Supreme Court in 2018. Most notably he led a successful multi-year campaign to pass the first-in-the-Nation Online Gaming Act in New Jersey. He worked to develop the regulatory regime put in force prior to launch. Pascrell continues to advise state governments across the nation on issues involving the gaming industry. Pascrell commenced his undergraduate career at Rutgers University, graduating Cum Laude from the Eagleton Institute of Politics and Public Administration. Seton Hall Law School awaited him next and prepared him for Harvard University's Kennedy School of Government Senior Executives in State Government Program. Pascrell is a member of the bar in Washington, D.C., and New Jersey, and is admitted to practice before the United States Supreme Court.
