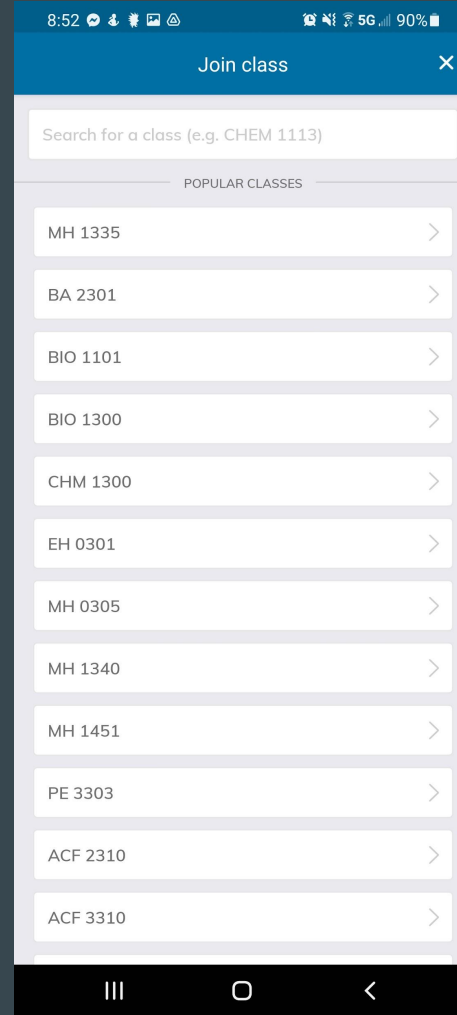
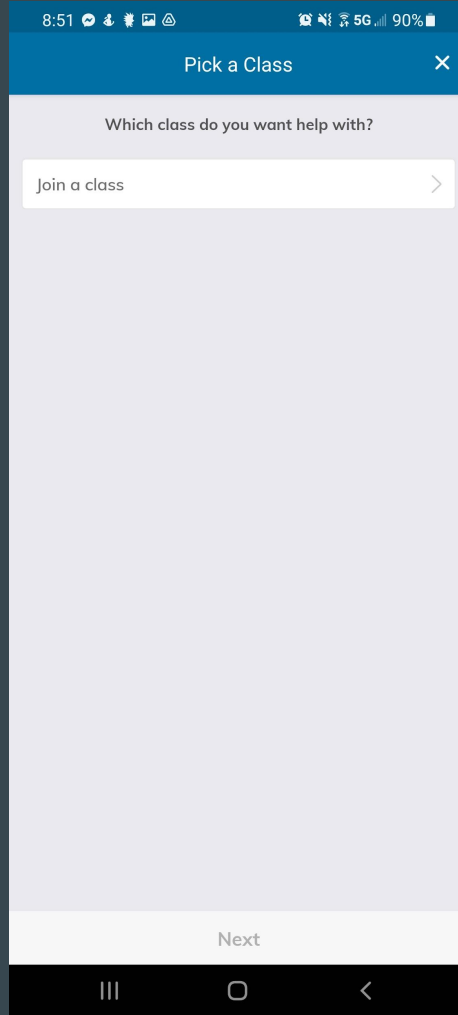
When you first log in it will be under the learn section of the app.

This will show if you have any appointments with a tutor.

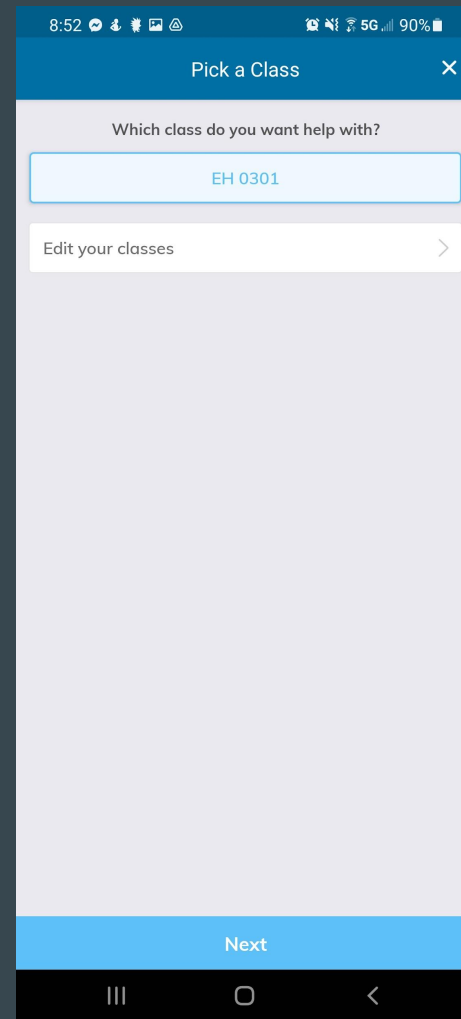
To make an appointment select the Schedule a single or weekly 30 minute session option.

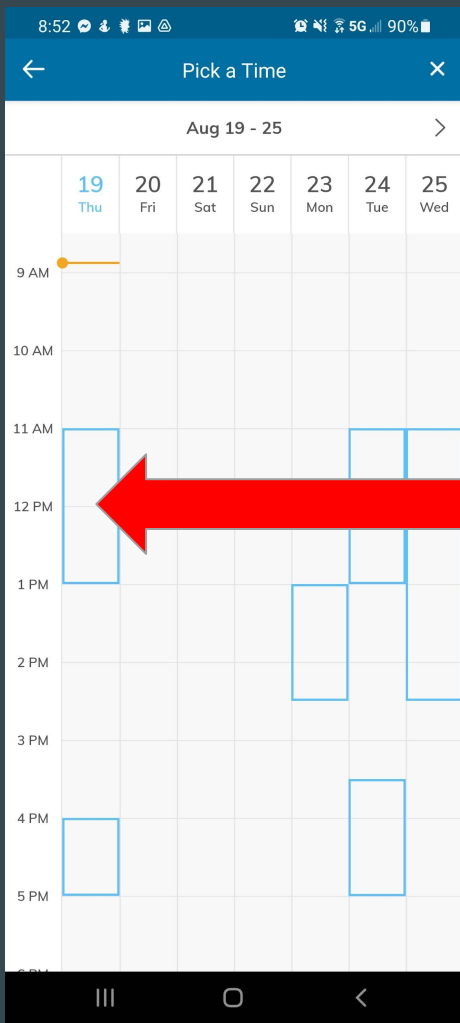


Next, Your class schedule should be already imputed but if it is not you can search for the Course ID for the course and select it from the list to join that course.



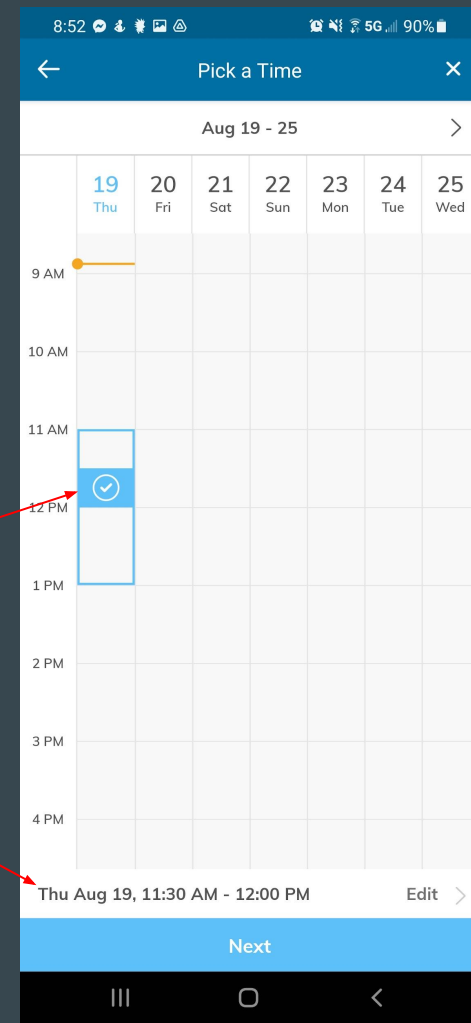
Once you have joined a course, it will then ask for which course you need tutoring. Select the class to continue. It should be highlighted in blue.

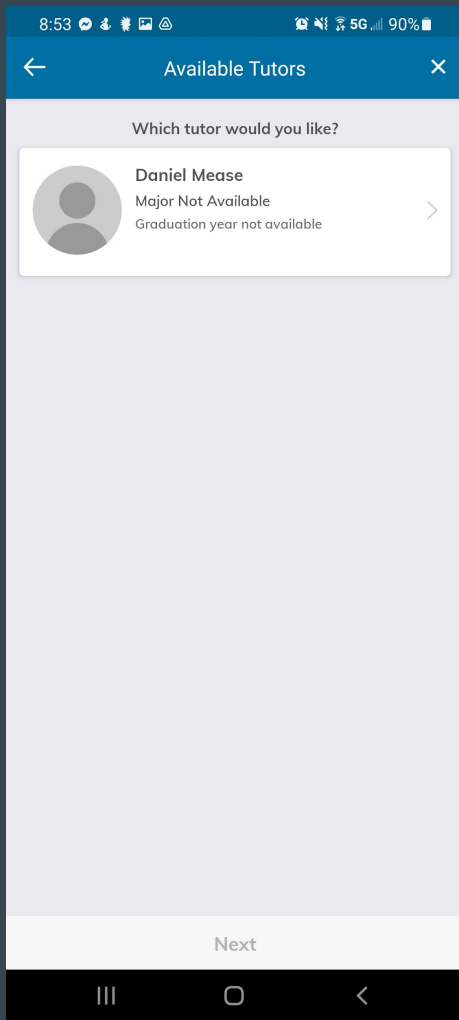




After selecting the course, you will then see the available times for tutoring as blue rectangles on the schedule. To schedule an appointment select a time within the blue rectangles. (The boxes are set within 30 min. increments.)

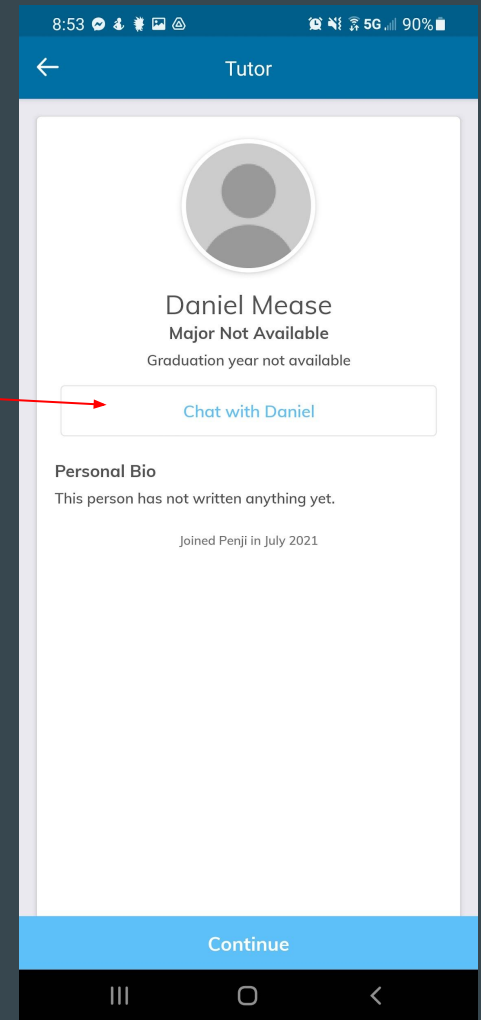
Once selected you will see a white check mark and the time and date displayed at the bottom of the screen.



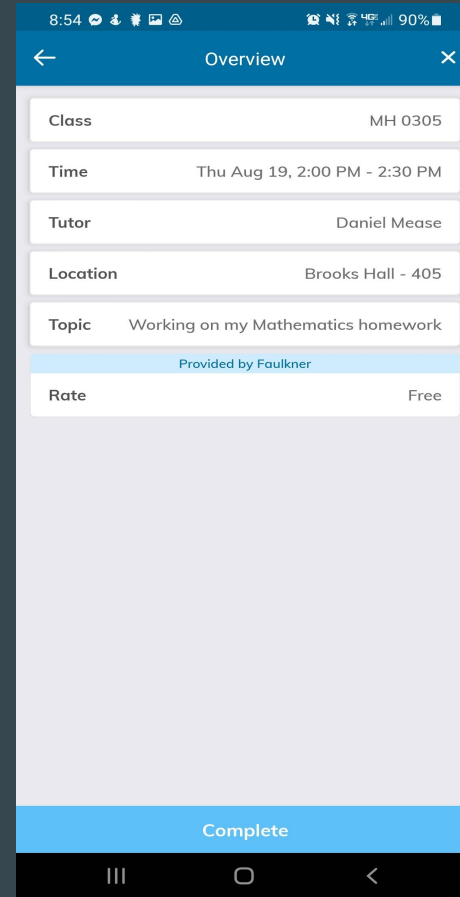
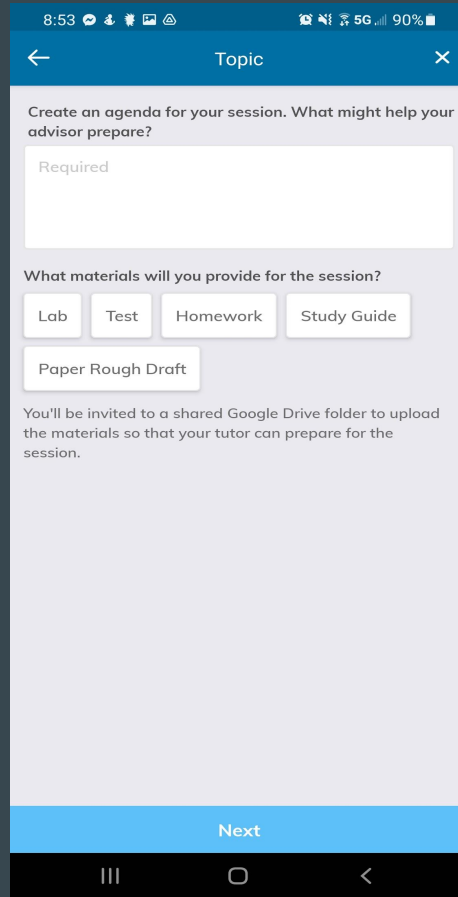
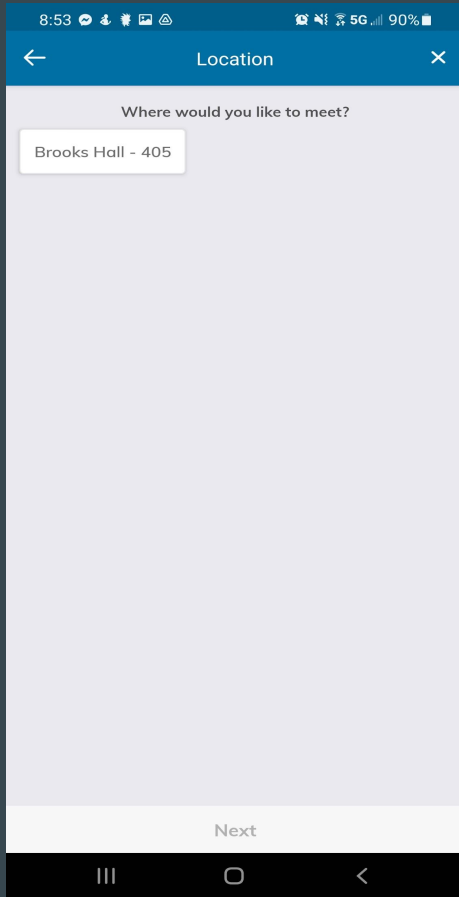


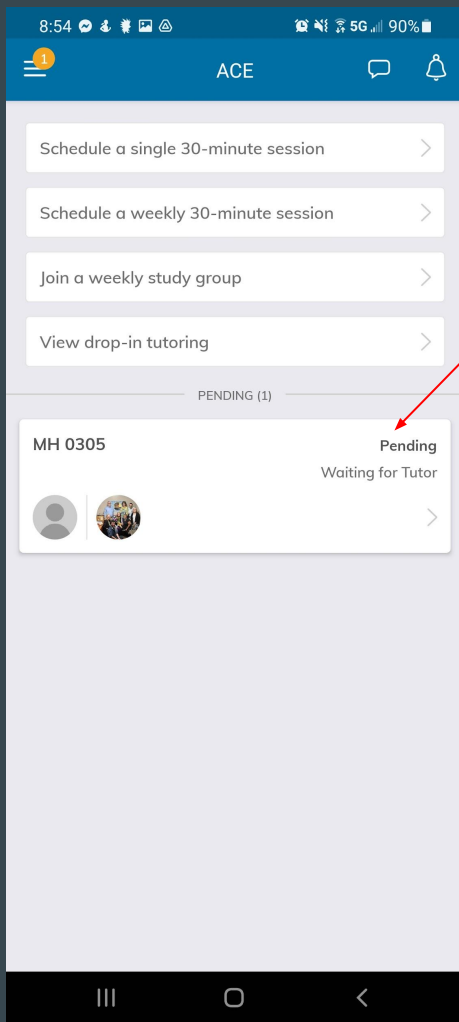
For the time that you have selected, you will be given a list of tutors that can help with that specific subject.

Selecting a tutor will give you information about that tutor and a chance to chat with the tutor, if necessary, before creating your appointment.



Next, choose where you would like to meet and provide information on what you need to work on during the session. Then you will see an overview of your appointment.





On the main page you will see your appointment, and it will say “Waiting for Tutor” until he or she accepts the appointment.

If you click on the session, then you can see the information from the overview as well as if the Tutor has accepted or not. The “View session chatroom” allows you to chat with your tutor. This can be helpful if you are running late or if you need to cancel your session.

After each appointment, we ask that you submit a session log so that we know how we are doing in the ACE.
