Finally, you will ensure students gain meaningful employment, actively connecting with employers to secure interviews and job placements.

Each day at HIM begins with devotion, utilizing the book Purpose Driven Life by Rick Warren to help students discover their purpose and set goals to achieve it. This role requires a relational leader who excels at building connections with staff, participants, community leaders, and donors, as well as collaborating with municipal agencies to enhance resources and support.

- Lead by example, engaging with students and staff in a supportive, relational way to foster personal and professional growth.
- Proactively engage employers to secure job opportunities for program graduates and set up interviews, ensuring successful employment outcomes for participants.
- Inspire and energize HIM's students, volunteers, alumni, and community partners to work together toward our mission of transforming lives.

Program Oversight
